NOTICE: CITY HOUSEHOLD GREEN SPRING WASTE PICK UP: MAY 2 AND MAY 9!



Take advantage of the extra pick up of your yard waste to clean up your yards to keep our neighborhood looking great! The instructions below are from the City website:

<http://www.cabq.gov/solidwaste/recycling/yard-waste/residential-yard-waste>

- “Residents must place their green waste (leaves, grass, and brush) in trash bags not weighing more than 40 lbs. each on the curb.
- Items must be placed 5 ft. away from the automated trash container. Branches must be cut to 4-ft. lengths and bundled securely.
- The City **WILL NOT PICK UP** dirt, construction debris, gravel, or any other landscape material.”

CRIME IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD
