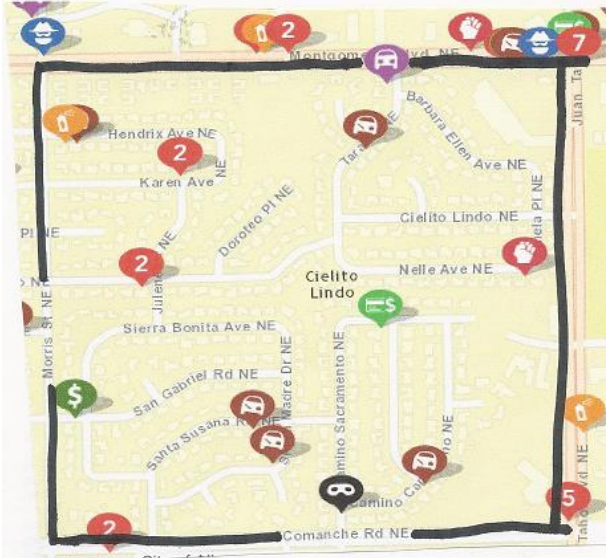

## CRIME IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD

Checking CrimeMapping.com shows the following fourteen crimes within our CLNA neighborhood that have generated a report (not including the businesses) from April 1, 2016 – September 1, 2016:



- One Auto Theft on Tara Drive
- One Vandalism on Hendrix Ave
- Two Thefts of Motor Vehicle Parts or Accessories on Karen
- One Vehicle Break In/Thefts on Tara Drive, on Santa Susana, on Santa Marino and on Camino Capistrano
- One Aggravated Assault on Nelle Ave
- Two Frauds on Cielito Lindo and one on Sierra Oscura
- One Theft/Larceny on Sierra Bonita Place
- One Burglary/Breaking and Entering on Camino Capistrano



Check crimemapping.com for more detailed information about the crimes including the date, time and incident number.

REMEMBER: A crime not reported is not a crime that police can track!

Side Notes: There are two on-going court cases for a property in our neighborhood with zoning violations due to weeds, litter, etc. Also, the drug house in the southeast quadrant of our neighborhood appears to be an ongoing problem.
